The members of the Capital Area Trail Riders Association, Inc. welcome you to CATRALand for the 2007 CATRA PeeWee Scramble and Hare Scramble.

This year, once again NETRA requires a strict noise test and we know that someone is going to fail and go home mad because they weren't allowed to race. PLEASE, make your bikes conform to the 96 dB limit (per AMA/NETRA SAE J1287 test procedure). Go to tech ASAP to avoid a long line and to get a second chance if you need it.

We hope you have an enjoyable time here at CATRALand and ask you to follow these simple rules to keep this a positive experience for everyone:

- Help us keep CATRALand clean for future events. There is no trash service at CATRALand, so we ask you to please take your own trash. Do not dispose of any trash in the portacans.
- TENTS must be down by 9am Sunday to allow for parking.
- Please park where a club member directs you. Our parking area is small and we are expecting a large turnout.
- There is no pit riding or riding on the main road. There is a marked trail leading from the parking area to the pavilion. Please use this trail at a maximum speed of 5 mph.
- No riding WITHOUT a helmet. No exceptions!
- No open pit fires. There are metal fire pits provided.
- Quiet hours begin at 10:00 p.m. No generators or excessive noise. Be courteous to your fellow racers.
- No dogs or riding of bicycles allowed, for insurance reasons.
- No fireworks... PERIOD!
- Spectators must use caution when walking in the woods. Do not stand on the trail. Do not cross the trail in front of oncoming bikes. Also pack out anything you bring into the woods.

Club members and race workers are wearing yellow t-shirts with CATRA on the back. Additional information about CATRA can be found at the pavilion. Concessions are available both Saturday and Sunday at the pavilion.
